

The Governor's Coordinated Care Initiative calls for implementing the duals demonstration in 10 counties. Today, the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) and Department of Social Services (DSS) selected the initial four counties to implement the demonstration under current legislative authority (SB 208, 2010).

The Alameda Alliance for Health was not among the initial plans selected. However, we look forward to working with your organization to help prepare your plan and county for implementation. Pending further state and federal authority, we hope to achieve our shared goals of improved care coordination, better beneficiary health and a more efficient delivery system in Alameda County.
