

We are pleased to inform you that Health Net has been selected to participate as an integrated health plan in the Duals Demonstration in Los Angeles and San Diego counties. Both counties are among the four counties selected to proceed under current state authority to implement the proposed demonstration. The department looks forward to working with you to achieve the goals of improved care coordination, better beneficiary health, and a more efficient delivery system.

Health Net has more than 15 and 17 years of experience operating as a Medi-Cal managed care in Los Angeles County and San Diego County, respectively. In this capacity, you have partnered with the state to serve the most vulnerable populations, including seniors and persons with disabilities. Additionally, Health Net has provided Medicare benefits to dual eligible beneficiaries through its Dual Eligibles Special Needs Plan (D-SNP) in both counties. Both programs are accredited by the National Committee for Quality Assurance (NCQA), indicating quality care and service delivery.

This local experience coupled with the Health Net's ability to draw on experience from its program innovations in other states, convinced the reviewers that you have the infrastructure and preparation to achieve success.
