# CALIFORNIA BRIDGE TO REFORM DEMONSTRATION (NO. 11-W-00193/9) TECHNICAL CHANGE TO ATTACHMENT N OF THE SPECIAL FOR MEDI-CAL COVERAGE TO INCLUDE BEHAVIORAL HEALTH THERAPY FOR CHILDREN AGED 0 TO 21

Dear Mr. Boben, Ms. Hossain and Ms. Lee:

The State of California requests a technical change to Attachment N of the Special Terms and Condition (STCs) to allow for the addition of behavioral health therapy (BHT) to the list of covered benefits available to children aged 0 to 21 years who have a diagnosis of autism spectrum disorder (ASD). Given the urgency in the state to operationalize this program change, we request your expedited review and approval of

this technical change, with an effective date to mirror the date approved in the corresponding state plan amendment authorizing BHT.

## Background

On July 7, 2014, the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) released guidance regarding the coverage of BHT services pursuant to section 1905(a)(4)(B) of the Social Security Act (the Act) for Early and Periodic Screening, Diagnostic and Treatment services (EPSDT). Section 1905(r) of the Act defines the EPSDT benefit to include a comprehensive array of preventive, diagnostic, and treatment services for low-income infants, children and adolescents under age 21. The guidance further clarified that states are required to provide coverage to individuals eligible for the EPSDT benefit for any Medicaid covered service listed in section 1905(a) of the Act that is determined to be medically necessary to correct or ameliorate any physical or behavioral conditions. In recognition of this clarification, the State is in process of securing the necessary federal approvals for providing BHT under the preventive category and incorporating the benefit into Medi-Cal managed care.

The proposed correction would add two additional rows to *Attachment N Capitated Benefits Provided in Managed Care*, to include a reference to "Behavioral Health Treatment" and "Preventive Services". A redlined version of the document with these changes reflected on page 1 and 17 is attached with this letter. Additionally, DHCS will provide an update to Attachment K of the STCs to reflect the fiscal assumptions of this change in a follow up to this submission.
