## DISCUSSION

In reviewing the NTP performance reports, the Department of Alcohol and Drug Programs (ADP) has decided that the information contained in the annual year-end cost settlement information, which is based on billing activity, is adequate to measure NTP performance. By changing policy, the year-end cost settlement information is now identified as the Performance Report of the NTP provider. No action is required by counties or NTP providers as a result of this policy change.

The NTP Performance Report created by ADP will now be referred to as the "NTP Performance Summary Report" and will be available upon request. California Health and Safety Code Sections 11758.42 (i)(2) and (j)

#### BACKGROUND

Health and Safety Code enables NTP providers who bill Drug Medi-Cal exclusively, or who bill the State for Drug Medi-Cal and serve only Substance Abuse Crime Prevention Act funded persons, to submit performance reports in lieu of cost reports.

In lieu of the NTP providers submitting a performance report, a policy decision was developed in agreement with counties and providers that ADP would produce and disseminate the performance report based on billing activity. While the language in the Health and Safety Code does not change, the process by which performance report information will be disseminated has changed.
