Welfare and Institutions Code Section(s)	Data Element
5402(a)(1) & 5402(a)(18) (A-E)	The number of individuals <b>detained</b> in designated and approved facilities for 72-hour assessment, evaluation, and crisis intervention (W&I Code Section 5150) for each of the following conditions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>» Danger to Self.</li><li>» Danger to others.</li><li>» Grave Disability due to a mental health disorder.</li><li>» Grave disability due to a severe substance use disorder.</li><li>» Grave disability due to both a mental health disorder and a severe substance use disorder.</li></ul>
W&I Code Section 5402(a)(2)	The number of persons transferred to mental health facilities pursuant to Section 4011.6 of the Penal Code in each county.

W&I Code Section 5402(a)(5) (A-E)	The number of individuals detained for 72-hour assessment, evaluation, and crisis intervention either once, between two and five times, between six and eight times, and greater than eight times for each type of detention (W&I Code Section 5150)
W&I Code Section 5402(a)(10)	Age Sex Gender Identity Race Ethnicity Sexual Orientation Veteran Status Housing Status Primary Language
W&I Code Section 5402(a)(11)	» The number of county contracted beds

Welfare and Institutions Code Section(s)	Data Element
W&I Code Section 5402(a)(7)	» The services provided or offered to individuals detained for 72-hour assessment, evaluation, and crisis intervention (W&I Code Section 5150). Data pertaining to services shall specify payer information or funding used to pay for services
W&I Code Section 5402(a)(6)	The clinical outcomes of individuals detained in designated and approved facilities for 72-hour assessment, evaluation, and crisis intervention (W&I Code Section 5150).
W&I Code Section 5402(a)(8) &(9)	» The waiting periods for individuals detained prior to receiving an evaluation or receiving evaluation and treatment services in a designated facility, including the reasons for waiting periods (W&I Code Section 5150). If the source of admission is an emergency department, the date and time of service and release from emergency care.
