





- Limited Understanding of Importance of Preventive Medical & Health Care


Strategies


Results: Academic Performance Index Growth


Results: Comparison of Academic Performance Index with All Lemon Grove School District Schools


Results: Latino Academic Performance Index


Results: African American Academic Performance Index




Student Attendance
