

Program Options for People with Medicare & Medi-Cal


If you have Medicare and Medi-Cal, you know it can be hard to figure out which program covers which of your services. We want to help you get all the care you need.

Who is a Dual Eligible?

A dual eligible member is an individual who has both Medicare and Medi-Cal coverage. Dual eligibles are also known as Medi-Medis.

What Programs Can Help Me?

There are two programs that can help you get the care you need:



1 Cal MediConnect helps with BOTH your Medicare and Medi-Cal services. You have one health plan to call and a main point of contact who helps connect all your Medicare and Medi-Cal doctors, health care workers, and support services.

2 The Health Homes Program (HHP) helps connect your Medi-Cal doctors and services. It works best when you get all your services through Medi-Cal. The HHP will try to work with your Medicare doctors and services, but Medicare doctors do not have to work with the HHP.



What Services do Medicare & Medi-Cal Cover?

The table below shows the main services covered by Medicare and Medi-Cal if you have both.

Who Can Enroll in Cal MediConnect?

To enroll in a Cal MediConnect health plan, you must:

- 1** Be at least 21 years old
- 2** Have **both** Medicare **and** Medi-Cal coverage
- 3** Not have other health coverage, such as retirement, veterans, or private coverage
- 4** Live in one of the following counties:
 - Los Angeles
 - Orange
 - Riverside
 - San Bernadino
 - San Diego
 - San Mateo
 - Santa Clara

Who Can Get HHP Services?

To get HHP services, you must meet all 3 of these requirements:

- 1** Be enrolled in a Medi-Cal health plan;
- 2** Have certain chronic health conditions, including:
 - a. Health issues (such as asthma, diabetes, kidney or liver disease, heart failure, etc.) and/or
 - b. Mental health issues (such as major depression, bipolar disorder, or schizophrenia);
- 3** Have been in the hospital, had visits to the emergency room, or do not have a place to live



You can choose to get HHP services if you qualify.

Joining the HHP will not take away your Medi-Cal or Medicare services.

Do the HHP and Cal MediConnect Work Together?

You cannot be in both HHP and Cal MediConnect.

If you live in one of the counties listed on the previous page, you can choose whether to join the HHP or Cal MediConnect, or you can keep your care the way it is today.
