THE EXTENSION OF THE QUALIFYING INDIVIDUAL 1 PROGRAM

SUNSET DATE TO SEPTEMBER 31, 2003

(Ref: All County Welfare Directors Letter Nos.: 98-08, 98-15, 98-47,

98-60, 99-14, 99-43, 99-61, and 03-02)

This letter notifies counties of the extension of the Qualifying Individual 1 (QI-1) Program sunset date to September 31, 2003.

The QI-1 program provides the state payment of the Medicare Part B premium for individuals with income below 135 percent of the federal poverty level. The QI-1 program was scheduled to sunset December 31, 2002, but Congress initially granted a temporary extension to March 31, 2003. Congress has now appropriated funding for the QI-1 program and the sunset date has been extended through September 21, 2003.

Counties are to continue accepting applications and setting up cases for the QI-1 program. Department of Health Services will continue to keep county staff updated on the status of the QI-1 program.
