
Do you have CalMediConnect?

On January 1, 2023, your Cal MediConnect plan will change to a **Medicare Medi-Cal Plan**.

A Medicare Medi-Cal Plan, also known as a Medi-Medi Plan, will provide the same benefits that you get today, with no gap in coverage. The Medi-Medi Plan will be provided by the same company that provides your Cal MediConnect. If you are in Cal MediConnect today, you do NOT need to do anything to join a Medi-Medi Plan and keep your current benefits.



Medi-Medi Plans help coordinate care for people with both Medicare and Medi-Cal.

- ✓ You will still get the same health care benefits as you do today.
- ✓ Your new Medi-Medi Plan will help you with all your health care needs. It will continue to coordinate your benefits and care. This includes medical and home and community-based services. It also includes medical supplies and medications.
- ✓ The Medi-Medi Plans will include the doctors you see today or help you find a new doctor that you like.

You will start getting letters about this change from your Cal MediConnect plan in October 2022. You do not have to do anything this fall to keep getting your health care from the plan you have today. If you have questions about your coverage in 2022, contact your Cal MediConnect plan.
