Children's Health Measures – Pediatric Dashboard Update Paul Reggiardo, D.D.S: The methodology used for 2015 was very clear regarding the 90 days. What methodology was used for 2013-14? Is there any way DHCS can reconcile the different measurements used for 2013- 14 for an apples-to-apples comparison?	Anastasia Dodson, DHCS: We will review the data and look at providing clarification on the methodology and data that is consistently across multiple years.	DHCS will be posting an updated children's health dashboard as well as data on the <u>DHCS Dental</u> <u>Data Reports website</u> that will include data from 2013 through 2016 using a consistent methodology across multiple years. In the prior version of the Children's Health Dashboard, Calendar Year (CY) 2013 data for Dental Fee-for-Service data used a different denominator than CY 2014 and 2015 in calculating utilization percentages. The

		denominator for CY 2013 was based on beneficiaries eligible at least 11 out of 12 months with no more than a 1 month gap in eligibility for the measurement year. The denominator for CY 2014 was based on beneficiaries with at least 90 days of continuous eligibility.
Children's Health Measures – Pediatric Dashboard Update Paul Reggiardo, D.D.S: For figure 7, the use of sealants category refers to FFS and not Dental Managed Care data?	Anastasia Dodson, DHCS: Yes, we can fix that.	Future iterations of the Pediatric Dashboard will include both Fee- for-Service and Dental Managed Care data.
