The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) submits the enclosed January 2020 Senior Care Action Network (SCAN) Annual Network Certification Assurance of Compliance Report confirming that the Medi-Cal Managed Care Health Plan (MCP) contracted with the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is compliant, or has been deemed compliant, with the network certification requirements set forth in 42 Code of Federal Regulations (C.F.R.) §§438.206, 438.207, and 438.68.
