#### DSS Updates (Vickie Smith)

• No updates from community care licensing

#### **CDPH Updates** (Miren Klein)

- Vaccine Updates
  - 1. Almost 7.6 million doses administered; 1.5 million Californians have received both doses
  - 2. Delay in shipments due to severe storms.
  - 3. Reviewing the Johnson & Johnson vaccine with FDA this Friday (Feb. 26).
  - 4. Pharmacy retail partnership
    - a. CVS and Rite Aid given 1 million of Moderna vaccines
    - b. This week it was doubled with another million of Pfizer
    - c. CA now at 120,000 dose allocations so Walgreens has been added and CVS has expanded locations
    - d. COVID-19 vaccination appointment sign up links for retail pharmacy partners Rite Aid, Walgreens and CVS are below:

  - 5. Prioritization guidelines
    - a. Target right now is 65 and older and healthcare workers.
    - b. Beginning March 15 health care providers can use their clinic judgment to vaccine those age 16-64 with disabilities or conditions putting them at high risk of COVID-related morbidity and mortality
    - c. Implementation group coming together to figure out how to operationalize the distribution of the vaccine to vulnerable populations.
    - d. March 1: begin to prioritize staff working in school and child care and allocate 10% of doses to this group.
  - 6. No updates on third-party partner Blue Shield; should have more information next week.

# DHCS Licensing and Certification (Janelle Ito-Orille)

• TB Testing

 DHCS heard your concerns regarding staff getting the test within 7 days of employment. On Feb. 19, DHCS released guidance on TB testing and the COVID vaccine. <u>Information Notice 21-009</u> In accordance with CDC guidance, DHCS is asking that if a staff person or client has received the COVID vaccine and it will delay the TB test, please provide documentation in their file. #### **Questions and Answers**

# **Q**: Is there any conversation around prioritizing people who are HIV positive for vaccination?

A: No specific guidance yet; the implementation group will work on this but at this point it is not prioritized.

# Q: What is the status of prioritizing African American and Latinx people for vaccination?

*A: There is a strong focus on equity* and we are working to ensure there is a focus on the hard-to-reach populations.

#### Q: What is the expected timeline for moving to teachers and food workers?

**A:** Prioritization of teachers will start statewide on March 1 and give 10% of vaccine allocation to this group. Certain counties are already doing clinics to work with farm workers through mobile clinics and community based organizations.

# Q: Any update on the Johnson & Johnson vaccine?

**A**: We are looking forward to the FDA meeting this Friday, Feb. 26; we should expect to hear over the weekend if they will receive the emergency use authorization.

# Q: Can this call begin to address capacity issues and overdose rates which are a by-product of the pandemic?

A: DHCS continues to prioritize new license applications for residential treatment programs. DHCS

BHIN 20-017 provides more information on the application process.

# Q: Is there any similar TB and vaccine guidance for CCL licensed facilities where they just have to show their vaccine card to not delay placement?

A: CDSS is working on a Provider Information Notice (PIN); it will most likely mirror CDPH guidance.

# Q: Any info about vaccinating residential BHS clients?

A: Prioritization of ages 16-64 will be based on provider discretion after March 15.

# Q: Where is the first unit for COVID psych open?

**A:** While the Stockton facility is not the first facility, it is scheduled to open this week, but still has to secure approvals.

# Q: Is there any new safety guidance related to post vaccination, i.e. what is required of staff to maintain safety even after receiving both vaccinations? OR- is it just continue the same CDC guidelines of masking & social distancing?

A: Post vaccination, you should follow the same safety precautions as you did prior to being vaccinated.
