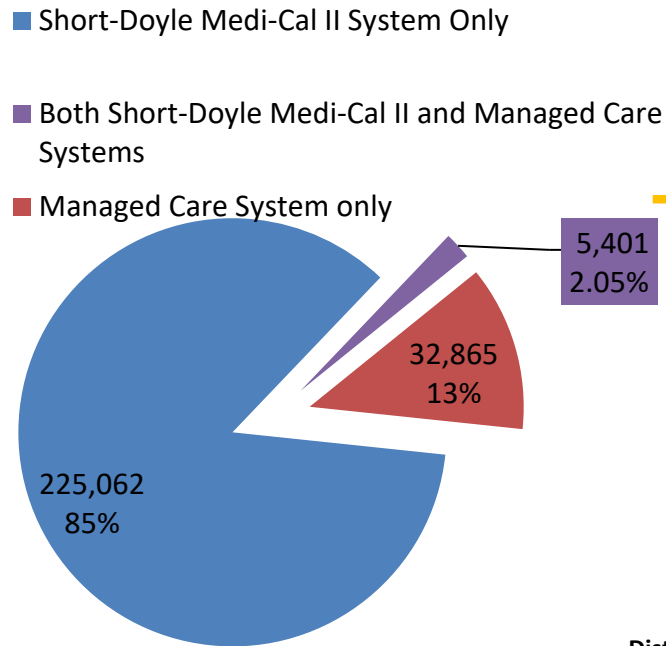


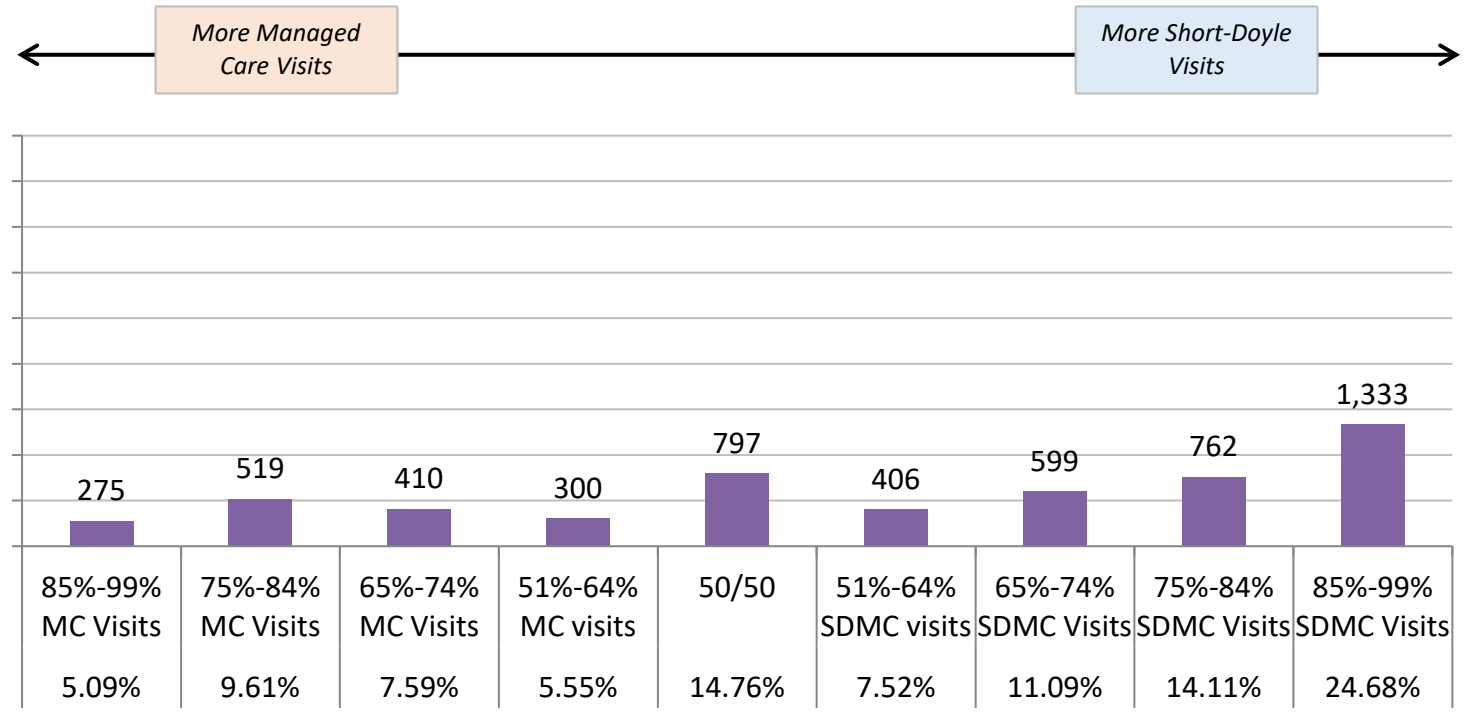

 FY 2013-2014, n = 5,401

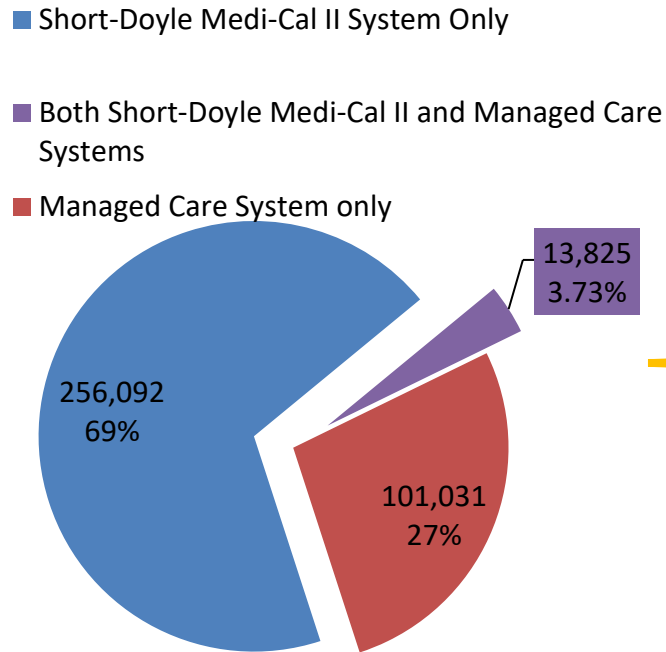

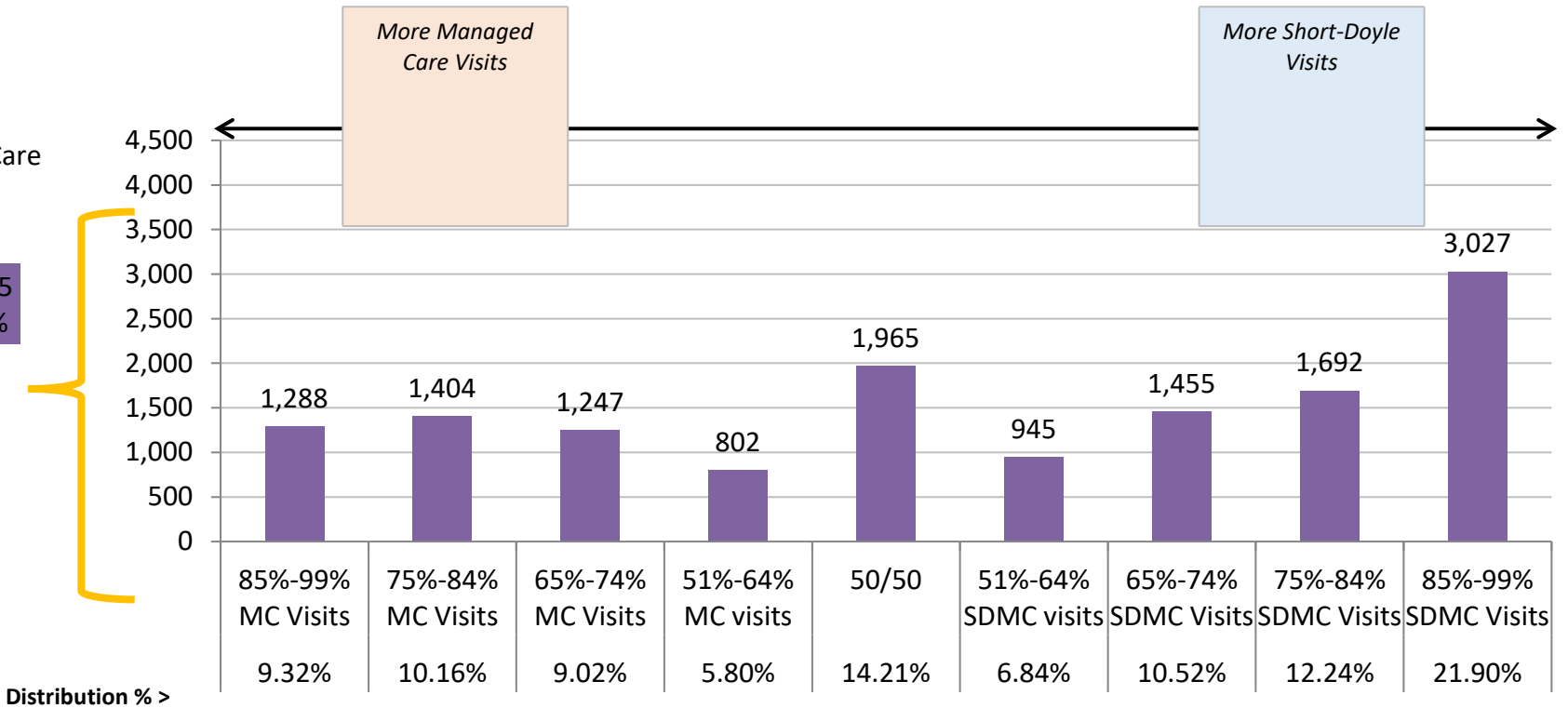

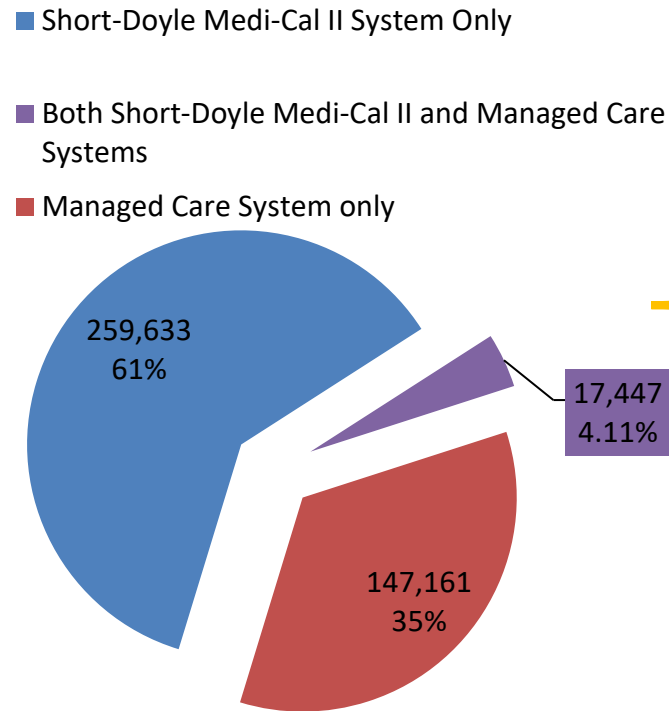

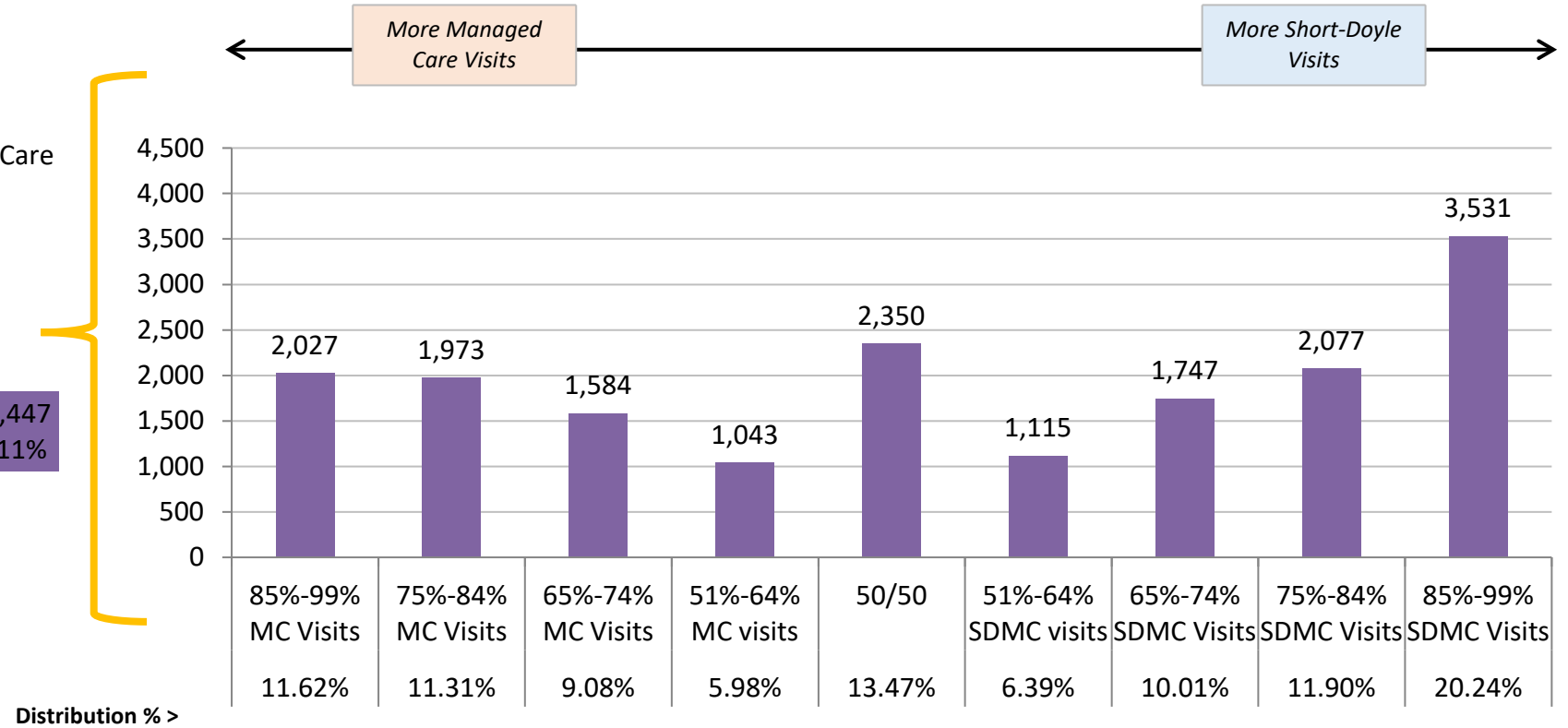

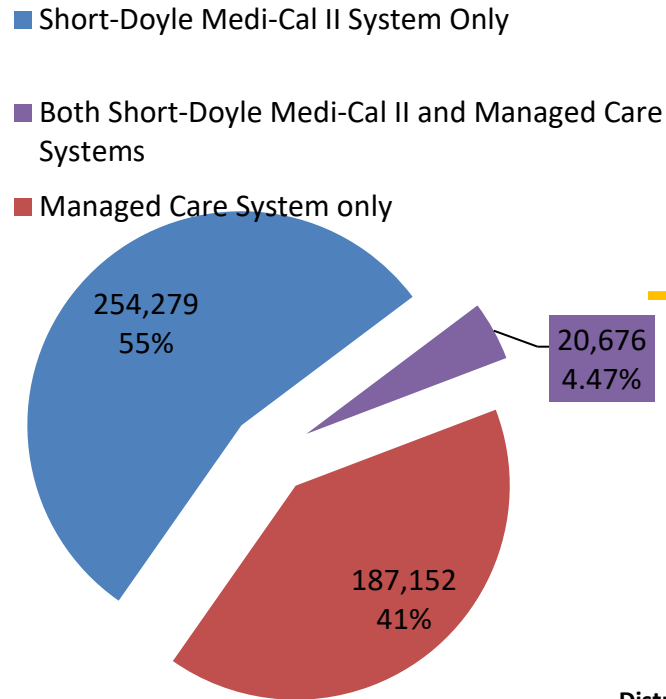

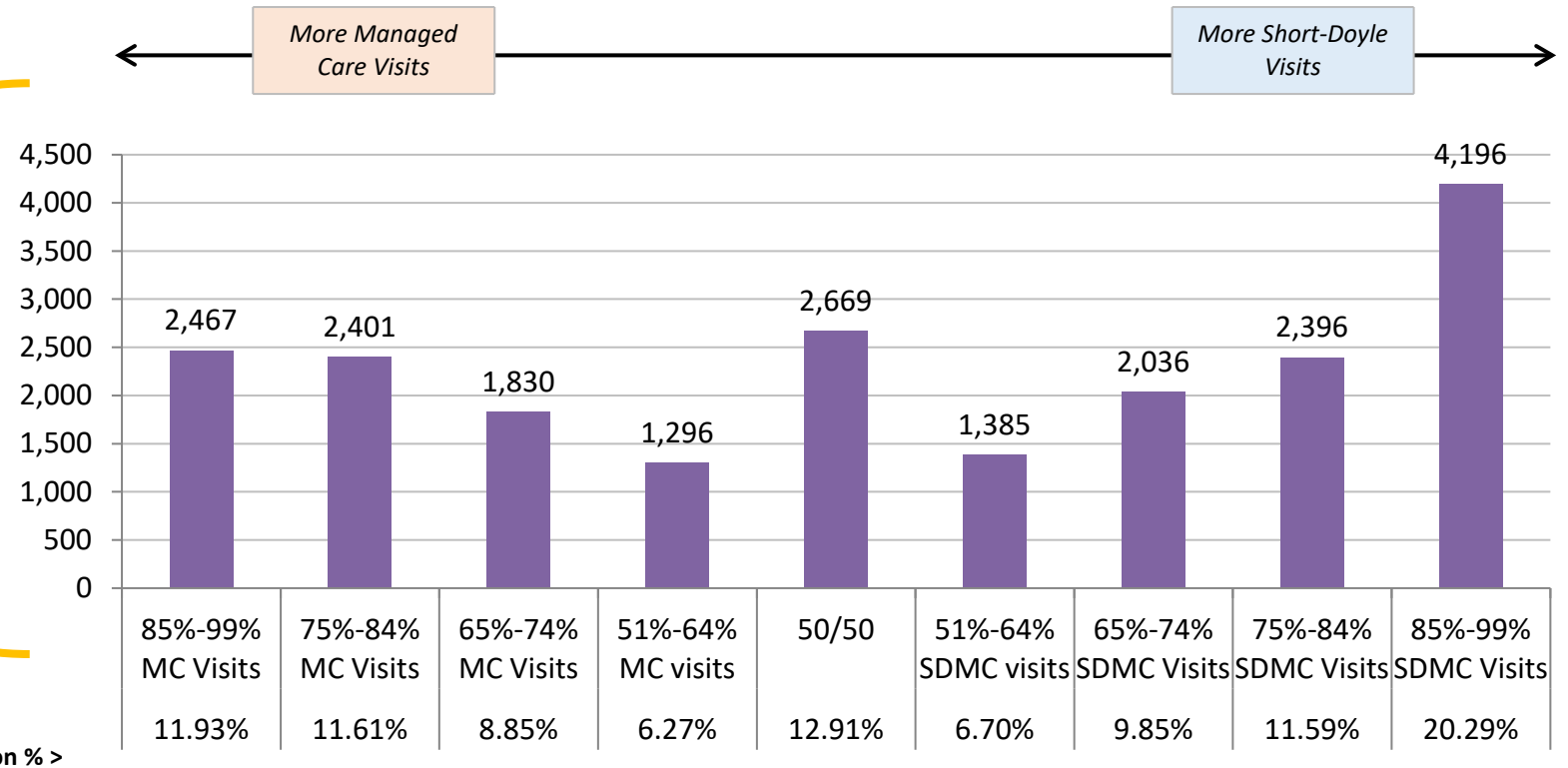
