On Wednesday morning, the Human Resources Committee, the Quality Improvement Committee, and the Policy and System Development Committee will meet. On Wednesday afternoon, the Legislation, Regulation, and Funding Committee, and the Cultural Competence Committee will meet. Members of the public are welcome to attend and observe these meetings. The Children and Youth, Adult, Transition Age Youth, and Older Adult System of Care Subcommittees will not meet at this quarterly meeting.

On Thursday, morning, the CMHPC will hold a special General Session to discuss and approve a proposed revised committee and meeting structure. On Friday morning, Senator Elaine Alquist has been invited to provide the opening remarks to kick off the General Session, and Cary Martin, President of the California Association of Local Mental Health Boards and Commissions will update us on its activities and the California Mental Health Director's Association will report on impact of the proposed State Budget on counties.

The CMHPC will also provide time on the agenda on Thursday at 4:45 p.m. and on Friday at 11:30 a.m. for members of the public to voice their concerns about mental health issues of importance to them.
