- SUBJECT: REGIONAL AVERAGE RATES FOR NON-CONTRACT PSYCHIATRIC INPATIENT HOSPITALS FOR FISCAL YEAR (FY) 2018-19

California Code of Regulations (CCR) Title 9, Section 1820.115 requires the Department of Health Care Services to calculate the reimbursement rates for acute psychiatric inpatient hospital services for each Fee-for-Service/Medi-Cal (FFS/MC) hospital that does not have a contract with a Mental Health Plan.

The per diem rate by accommodation code is equal to the weighted average per diem rates by accommodation code negotiated for all FFS/MC hospitals within the five rate regions defined in CCR, Section 1820.115(i). If there are no FFS/MC hospitals within the rate region with a negotiated rate for an accommodation code, the weighted average per diem rate for that accommodation code is equal to the weighted average negotiated for all FFS/MC hospitals statewide. The per diem rates include routine and hospital-based ancillary services, but exclude professional services. Enclosure 1 displays the FY 2018-19 rates by accommodation code and rate region.
