SUBJECT: DEACTIVATION OF "CGP" PREFIX INPATIENT PROVIDER NUMBERS

The purpose of this notice is to inform you that effective September 1, 2005, all in-state Type 81 Institutional "CGP" prefix Inpatient Provider Numbers will be deactivated. With this change, claims for inpatient hospital services provided to all California Children's Services (CCS) and Genetically Handicapped Persons Program clients (including those who are not Medi-Cal eligible) submitted for adjudication on or after September 1, 2005, must be billed with an appropriate Medi-Cal provider number.

Effective September 1, CCS/GHPP providers can no longer bill with a "CGP" provider number, and must bill using a Medi-Cal provider number. County CCS programs and CMS Branch Regional Offices that receive claims from a provider using their "CGP" prefix Inpatient Provider Numbers that will be adjudicated by Electronic Data Systems (EDS) on or after September 1, 2005, are directed to return the claim and inform the provider to re-bill using their Medi-Cal provider number. Claims that are billed with a "CGP" provider number, received for adjudication by EDS will be denied.
