

GENDER ELIGIBILITY FOR QUADRIVALENT HUMAN PAPILLOMA

VIRUS VACCINE (HPV4) TO INCLUDE MALE POPULATION

Attached is CHDP Provider Information Notice 15-05 informing providers that, in addition to CHDP code 76 (please refer to CHDP Provider Information Notice No.: 12-02) for the routine VFC administration fee for HPV4, CHDP has also changed the gender indicator to "both" for CHDP local codes 77 and 78 to permit reimbursement to providers who administer this Non VFC vaccine to males ages 19 years through 20 years 11 months.
