In response to the September 22, 2022 request from the California Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS) is granting a 90-day temporary extension of California's 1915(c) Home and Community-Based (HCBS) waiver for individuals who are medically fragile and technology dependent. The current temporary extension is scheduled to expire on September 27, 2022. This temporary extension allows the California Home and Community Based Alternatives Waiver (CMS Control Number CA 0139.R05) to continue operating through December 26, 2022, at cost and utilization levels approved for the fifth year of the waiver program with federal financial participation.

During the last temporary extension period, CMS reviewed the state's draft responses to the formal request for information (RAI) and provided the state with guidance on outstanding issues. As authorized by 42 CFR §441.304(c), CMS is granting this temporary extension to provide the state with additional time for the state to respond to the CMS formal RAI and resubmit a revised waiver renewal application.

Please update CMS on the progress of responding to the formal RAI and provide us with target dates for submission of the waiver renewal application as soon as possible.
