NOTES:

- Domestic services such as housework, laundry, shopping/errands, and meal preparation cannot be authorized under WPCS.
- Adult Companionship cannot be authorized for minors.
- If the minor is authorized for Protective Supervision from In Home Supportive Services (IHSS), the Case Management Team (CMT) should consider any supervision needs for the Activities of Daily Living (ADL)/Instrumental Activities of Daily Living (IADL) as well.
- The CMT may authorize Paramedical through the HCBA Waiver to be provided by a parent provider without need for extraordinary circumstances. The minor must be receiving Paramedical services through the IHSS program to be authorized for Paramedical through the HCBA waiver.
- This information is provided as a guideline only. Each minor must be assessed individually.
- *Denotes this is not age appropriate for WPCS. Consider Paramedical.
