Your answers to the questions below are required to assist your Transition Coordinator's ability to identify and secure qualified housing in your community. Your answers will not affect your eligibility for Medi-Cal or CCT. However, past financial and/or legal problems may limit your ability to qualify for private or publicly-subsidized housing. It is very important for you to tell your Transition Coordinator about these issues, so (s)he can help you find and secure alternative living arrangements.
