## DHCS PHE Unwind Communications Strategy

Phase One: Encourage Beneficiaries to Update Contact Information

#### Launched recently

- Multi-channel communication campaign to encourage beneficiaries to update contact information with county offices.
- » Flyers in provider/clinic offices, social media, call scripts, and website banners
- Phase Two: Watch for Renewal Packets in the mail. Remember to update your contact information!
  - Launch 60 days prior to end of COVID-19 PHE.
  - Remind beneficiaries to watch for renewal packets in the mail and update contact information with their local county office if they have not already done so.

# Other recommendations by stakeholders

- » Training pathway
  - » 20 hours of training instead of 16
- » Experience pathway
  - » Three years of experience instead of seven
  - » Attendance at three births as a doula
  - » Total of three client testimonials or professional letters
- » Some trainings should be mandatory for all doulas

- » Length of postpartum period
- » Recommended trainings
- » Definition of "full spectrum" care
- » Proof of meeting training, experience, and continuing education requirements
