DHCS PHE Unwind Communications Strategy

Phase One: Encourage Beneficiaries to Update Contact Information

Launched recently

- Multi-channel communication campaign to encourage beneficiaries to update contact information with county offices.
- » Flyers in provider/clinic offices, social media, call scripts, and website banners
- Phase Two: Watch for Renewal Packets in the mail. Remember to update your contact information!
 - Launch 60 days prior to end of COVID-19 PHE.
 - Remind beneficiaries to watch for renewal packets in the mail and update contact information with their local county office if they have not already done so.

State Plan Amendment (SPA) Feedback

- » DHCS accepted comments on the draft SPA through April 13.
 » DHCS received more than 60 recommendations
- » DHCS will send an updated draft SPA pages to stakeholders in early May.
- » DHCS will informally submit the updated draft SPA pages to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services in early May.

Other recommendations by stakeholders

- » Training pathway
 - » 20 hours of training instead of 16
- » Experience pathway
 - » Three years of experience instead of seven
 - » Attendance at three births as a doula
 - » Total of three client testimonials or professional letters
- » Some trainings should be mandatory for all doulas
