2.	2017 Initiatives	 Rene Mollow (DHCS) Sandra Williams (DHCS) Thien Lam (CC) Katie Ravel (CC) James Duckens (CalHEERS) 	 CalHEERS provided an overview of populating the 24-Month Roadmap with initiatives rather than individual Change Request (CR) numbers. DHCS added that as they do their planning work, the roadmap will be populated. Further, they added stakeholder engagement is still a priority and there will be numerous opportunitites to submit feedback.

IAP 24-Month Roadmap	 Rene Mollow (DHCS) Sandra Williams (DHCS) Thien Lam (CC) Katie Ravel (CC) James Duckens (CalHEERS) 	 R16.2 Implementation Highlights CalHEERS provided a summary of changes in Release 16.2 Implementation and subsequent R16.2 priority releases, such as the Federal Povery Level updates. Provided updates for CR pending CalHEERS Release 16.4 (Implementation date 5/16/16): CR 52030 – SB 75 - Full Scope Medi-Cal for All Children Finalized eligibility and enrollment plan. CR 52313 – Prevent multiple/duplicate accounts, applications and cases in CalHEERS Prevents multiple applications. Advocates expressed concern this could adversely impact beneficiaries. Action Item: Discuss CR 52313 policy implications at Consumer Focused Stakeholder Workgroup.

- This CR is automating Covered California's manual process for removing APTC for non-tax filers.
- Consumers will still have the option to attest to filing their taxes and have their APTC restored prospectively.
- Release 16.4 Stakeholder/Advocate Testing has been scheduled for May 9th.
- Provided updates for CR pending CalHEERS Release 16.7 (Implementation date 7/25/2016):
 - CR 32277 Eligibility for IAP Based on Immigration Status (including merged PRUCOL CR 3068)
 - PRUCOL requirements from CR 3068 have been merged with this CR to develop a holistic approach to providing IAP coverage based on immigration status.
 - CR 3124 Non-Qualifying Immigrants (NQI) Medi-Cal Affordability Wrap
 - DHCS is working with advocates, the SAWS systems and Covered California to finalize notices and system requirements.
 - CR 52341 Unmarried Pregnant Women Under 21
 - o Pregnant Women Under 21: Exempts all household income when determining the eligibility for unmarried pregnant women not eligible for any other mandatory or optional categorically needy coverage group who are either (a) under age 21 and living with her parents and is not going to file a tax return for the taxable year or (b) under age 21 and is going to be claimed as a tax dependent by parents in the taxable year.
 - CR 12055: Electronic verification of Medicare enrollment from SSA via the federal hub
 - The purpose of this CR is to have CalHEERS program the use of electronic verification of Medicare enrollment received from Social Security Administration via the federal hub when determining eligibility under the ACA new adult expansion coverage group.
 - CR 52600: County of Responsibility / Electronic Inter-County Transfer (eICT)
 - This is needed in order for a consumer residing in one county to have their case managed in another county.
 - Postponed until 2017. There are systematic concerns that need to be addressed. All parties need to confirm operational processes are correct before moving forward.

- CR 3262: Provide APTC Members the Choice to Purchase Member Level Plans
 - Allows consumers to select separate, subsidized health plans on the same application. Also, splits APTC for a tax household across multiple enrollments, allowing federally-recognized American Indian/Alaskan Natives (AI/AN) APTC members to select an AI/AN plan separately from non-AI/AN family member(s).
- CR 31943: RIDP Text Changes
 - Text changes for new RIDP functionality in the Covered CA website.
- CR 56179 Provider Directory Functionality: Implements an integrated provider directory available to consumers directly through the CalHEERS website.
- CR 34752 CalHEERS to SAWS Horizontal Integration
 - The purpose of this CR is for CalHEERS to allow applicants to immediately continue on and complete an application for additional benefits, such as CalFresh and CalWORKS, to eliminate the wait time before having the opportunity to complete an application for additional benefits, to identify applicants more likely to be eligible for additional benefits and more actively encourage them to apply for those benefits, and to simplify the process for applying for additional benefits by utilizing the information already provided in the health application (this will occur within SAWS).
 - Action Item: Ensure CDSS will be attending the next AB 1296 meeting to provide updates and discuss CR 34752.
- Provided updates for CR pending CalHEERS Release 16.9 (Implementation date 9/26/2016):
 - o CR 46047: IAP Transition APTC to MC and MC to APTC
 - This CR is intended to address current gaps in functional and technical design of IAP transitions.
 - o CR 52314: Duplicate Applications Long Term Solution
 - This change is a request to generate notices to consumers if a CalHEERS account has been disabled and/or a case has been closed.
 - o CR 59947: Continuity of Care for Pregnant Women
 - o The purpose of this CR is to add functionality in CalHEERS to allow

			pregnant women to retain their current Insurance Affordability Program (IAP) or to transition to another IAP when the pregnant women is eligible and selects to transition to another IAP. CR 27819: Reasonable Opportunity Period Discontinuance This CR will automate the Reasonable Opportunity process for lawful presence, citizenship, SSN, incarceration and death. Consumers will be discontinued from eligibility for APTC/CSR/CCP automatically on the 96th day if they have failed to be e-verified or provide documentation to prove eligibility.
