



Health Navigators Project Phase III (Final Phase) Request for Application Announcement

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), Medi-Cal Eligibility Division is conducting a final application phase for interested Community-Based Organizations (CBOs) that would like to receive funding for the Health Enrollment Navigators Project (Navigators Project). DHCS is making the Navigators Project available to new and participating CBOs for “navigation services”, which include activities related to outreach, application assistance, enrollment, care utilization, troubleshooting, and retention activities. DHCS’ goal is to award funding to a single CBO within each of the seven un-awarded counties (listed below). Preference will be given to entities that have proven experience and expertise in providing or currently provide local navigation services to vulnerable populations, have an effective working relationship with the county welfare department (via a letter of support from the local county), and have the established infrastructure and/or capability for a rapid implementation of the approved work plan.

6. Support letter(s) from a county welfare department in the applied county or counties
