## **Summary of 06/15/15 Immigration Work Group Meeting**

## Agenda Items

## A) PRUCOL

- Social Security Number (SSN) Questions--Advocates are concerned about
  the questions that undocumented individuals and non-applicants are asked
  regarding SSN. They do not want undocumented individuals or nonapplicants to be asked for their SSN or to have to provide a reason why they
  are not providing an SSN. They would like hovered text to explain that
  providing an SSN is voluntary and is not required. MCED will follow up and
  provide information about the requirements of SSN.
- Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN)--Advocates would like to know how Covered CA uses the ITIN. Advocates believe that the ITIN is only used for undocs and if it is not necessary they would like to have that question removed. Advocates were informed that the ITIN can be used for other reasons and Covered CA will follow up regarding the use of ITIN.
- Application Question Concerns--Advocates raised concerns about the use
  of questions regarding residence since August 1996 and veteran or activeduty military status on the application. Their concern is that these questions
  would not collect all the information needed to make a Medi-Cal
  determination, and should only be asked of people whose income makes
  them appear Medi-Cal eligible. MCED will follow up.

## B) Immigration Status Verification Process

- Covered California Notices--Covered CA will be revising informational notices regarding the verification process. They will have a notice for individuals who need to submit documents and a notice for individuals who submitted the wrong documents. Notices will be in English and Spanish with a babel page. Looking into the option of email notices as well. There is not an estimated time line for notices yet. They will include information for DACA and will provide edited notices for review.
- Pre-populated Cover Sheet--Advocates are requesting that return cover sheet should be populated with case number, updated babel page and would like notices translated into all threshold languages. Covered CA will follow up.
- **Data on Inconsistencies**--Covered CA will provide data on inconsistencies for this year when that information is available.

- Individuals Incorrectly Enrolled in Covered California—Covered
   California will follow up on individuals that are not eligible for Covered CA but
   enrolled and if they have to repay subsidies for the time that they were
   incorrectly enrolled.
- Passport Country of Issuance--Advocates would like to know why the list for passport country of issuance only has certain counties listed. MCED will follow up to get information on how the countries on that list were identified.
- Remote Identity Proofing (RIDP)--Covered CA will provide a list of acceptable identity documents for RIDP. Advocates would like to know how many individuals are waiting to complete their application due to RIDP.
