SUBJECT: TREATMENT OF THE MEDICARE ADVANTAGE FLEX CARD

FOR NON-MODIFIED ADJUSTED GROSS INCOME (NON-MAGI).

The purpose of this All County Welfare Directors Letter (ACWDL) is to provide guidance to counties regarding the treatment of the Medicare Advantage Flex Card when determining Medi-Cal eligibility for Non-MAGI programs.

Background

The Medicare Advantage (MA) Flex Card is a supplemental benefit offered by participating MA plans. These cards are not issued by the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services (CMS), the federal Medicare program, or by the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS). Instead, they are provided directly by participating MA plans as an additional benefit to Medicare beneficiaries who are enrolled in those specific plans. Not all MA plans offer the flex card.

The MA Flex Card is a prepaid debit card, funded by the MA plan, and may be used to pay for eligible health-related expenses, which may include but are not limited to the following:

- Dental, vision, and hearing services
- Prescriptions and over the counter medications
- Copayments and Deductibles
- Medical equipment
- Healthy food and wellness-related purposes (depending on the MA plan)

Treatment for Non-MAGI Eligibility Determinations

The MA Flex Card is considered a supplemental benefit under a participating MA plan and is not treated as income or property for the purposes of Non-MAGI Medi-Cal eligibility determinations.
