## Medi-Cal Eligibility Division Information Letter No.: I 18-05

TO: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS ALL COUNTY MEDI-CAL PROGRAM SPECIALISTS/LIAISONS

SUBJECT: Non-Emergency Medical Transportation

The purpose of this letter is to provide information regarding non-emergency medical transportation (NEMT). NEMT is a covered Medi-Cal benefit for beneficiaries who need transportation to medically necessary covered services and when ordinary public or private conveyance is medically contra-indicated. NEMT is provided to beneficiaries via ambulance, litter van, wheelchair van, or by air.<sup>\*</sup> If a beneficiary has any questions regarding NEMT, the beneficiary should consult with their treating physician to request transportation options, and the physician can put them in touch with a NEMT provider.
