This letter is to announce the launch of the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS), Medi-Cal Eligibility Division, Eligibility Policy and Regulation Center (E-PARC) Pilot Website which can be found at <a href="https://www.e-parc.ca.gov">www.e-parc.ca.gov</a>. E-PARC is being developed to improve access to Medi-Cal eligibility guidelines contained in the All County Welfare Directors Letters (ACWDLs) that inform counties of changes in Medi-Cal eligibility laws, policies and procedures. In addition to a user-friendly search engine, the website has many useful features you may find helpful when researching Medi-Cal eligibility policy. For purposes of this pilot, E-PARC is currently populated with only four subject areas, Citizenship, Identity, Continuous Eligibility for Children and Mid-Year Status reporting.

We request that you spend some time using and navigating the E-PARC website during the month of July 2009 and complete an evaluation (you will find the link on the E-PARC home page). Evaluation feedback will be very important when the pilot period ends and work on enhancements begin in August.
