SUBJECT: 2009/2010 FAMILY MEMBER MAXIMUM BASE ALLOCATION AMOUNT

(REFERENCE: ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS LETTER

This is to provide counties with the updated family member maximum base allocation amount (per Section 1924(d) of the Social Security Act). The family member maximum base allocation amount is used to determine how much the long-term care (LTC) beneficiary may allocate to family members. Effective July 1, 2009, through June 30, 2010, this family member base allocation amount (for use in Section IX, A.2 and B.2 of the Allocation/Special Deduction Worksheet B – Form MAW (1/90)) for a family member living with the community spouse of a beneficiary with LTC status is \$1822 (the 2008/2009 family member maximum base allocation amount was \$1,750).
