(Errata to All County Welfare Directors Letter (ACWDL) 17-29)

The purpose of this All County Welfare Directors Letter (ACWDL) errata is to inform counties that the Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) will not implement the SI and CI "no benefits" aid codes as previously referenced on page 10 of ACWDL 17-29. However, Medi-Cal Eligibility Division (MCED) is currently developing an alternative process for reporting incarceration and Medi-Cal suspension. A Medi-Cal Eligibility Division Information Letter (MEDIL) is being developed to provide information on this alternative process.

Please note: The current Medi-Cal suspension policy remains unchanged and counties are advised to continue to follow the policy guidance outlined in ACWDLs 14-26 and 14-26E.
