ALL COUNTY WELFARE DIRECTORS LETTERS NO. 81-6 AND 81-13

The above referenced letters authorized you to implement two new statutory provisions, AB 2238 (SGA Disabled -- Deduction for IHSS Costs) and AB 1263 (Special Parenteral Hyperalimentation Programs) pending the filing of emergency regulations. In both cases the Office of Administrative Law did not agree that an emergency existed. As a result our regulations were repealed by that agency.

We are now in the process of refileing both sets of regulations on a nonemergency basis. Due to the time frames involved with nonemergency packages, the regulations will not be effective before the expiration dates given in the All County letters. Therefore Letters No. 81-6 and 81-13 should be retained until the regulations are issued. You are to continue to employ the provisions of these letters in eligibility determinations past the expiration dates.
