ERRONEOUS RAMOS NOTICES OF ACTION

Due to a computer processing problem, approximately 5,186 erroneous Ramos Notice of Action forms were mailed in November 1982.

The date (year only) contained on the Notice of Action was incorrect. The categories involved are Excess Income, Extended Eligibles and Long-Term Care recipient's. The information contained on the Excess Income and Extended Eligibles stated that the claimants had until November 1983 in which to return their forms to the county welfare department. The Long-Term Care notice stated that the claimants had until January 1982 to either be contacted by the county welfare department or that the county welfare department would contact them by January 1982. We have issued corrected Notices of Action to all categories involved along with a notice explaining the error. The Excess Income and Long-Term Care claimants will receive a December 1982 Medi-Cal card. The Extended Eligibles will receive a December 1982 and January 1983 Medi-Cal card. The attached register identifies the claimants involved.
