BELTRAN V. RANK (FORMERLY BELTRAN V. MYERS)

Re: All County Welfare Directors (ACWD) Letter No. 84-9

The written version of the March 3, 1984 court order in Beltran v. Rank has been received. This written order requires that one change be made in the procedures described in ACWD Letter No. 84-9.

ACWD Letter No. 84-9, at paragraph 6, directed that completed Beltran claims be mailed to the Department of Health Services (DHS) within 20 days of receipt or completion of the eligibility determination, whichever is later. The court's written order, dated April 6, 1984, has modified this requirement. Completed Beltran claims must now be mailed to DHS as soon as possible, but in no case later than five (5) working days from the date the county completed the eligibility determination or received the completed claim, whichever is later.
