## SUBJECT: USE OF MEDS SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER-VERIFICATION FIELD (SSN-VER) CODES TO VERIFY THE SSN

## PURPOSE

The purpose of this letter is to advise county welfare departments of a change in the policy which allows Eligibility Workers (EWs) to verify an applicant/beneficiary's SSN based on a Medi-Cal Eligibility Data System (MEDS) printout indicating a J code in the SSN-VER in situations where an SSN card is not available. This policy change is necessary because MEDS' SSN Verification Code values were redefined as part of the recently implemented daily SSN verification process via the federal State Verification and Exchange System (SVES).

## BACKGROUND

The federal Children's Health Insurance Program Reauthorization Act of 2009 included a provision effective January 2010 that allows states to meet the Deficit Reduction Act citizenship and identity verification requirements via a SSN match with the Social Security Administration (SSA) which will return citizenship verification status when available in SSA records. In order to take advantage of this simpler method of verifying citizenship and identity, MEDS changes were needed to replace the semi-annual SSN validation process via the SSA's old Enumeration Verification System (EVS) with a daily SSN verification process through SVES began September 25, 2009.

In order to provide better information regarding SSN Verification status and to clearly identify SSNs that have been verified via the new SVES SSN Verification Process, the old alpha SSN Verification Code values were assigned new meanings. Three of the old alpha codes (W, X and Y) were redefined to identify the SSN verification status of SSNs processed via the EVS SSN Verification or Referral processes and all existing MEDS records that had alpha values were updated to reflect one of those three values. While J was the most frequently occurring value, there were eight old SSN-VER code values that identified a verified SSN (A, B, C, D, J, K, L and M). All MEDS records with one of those values were changed to show a SSN-VER code W. The new W, X and Y SSN-VER code values are temporary values until those SSNs are reverified via the SVES SSN Verification Process, which will occur on a flow basis during 2010.

## USE OF THE NEW SSN-VER CODES TO VERIFY THE SSN

Policy developed during the previous semi-annual SSN validation process allowed EWs to verify an applicant's/beneficiary's SSN with a MEDS printout indicating a J code in the SSN-VER field in situations where a Social Security Card was not available. The changes in the SSN-VER codes associated with the new SVES SSN Verification Process necessitate changes in this policy.

The new SSN-VER code A is equivalent to the old SSN-VER code J and so a MEDS printout dated after September 25, 2009, with an A SSN-VER code may be used by EWs to verify an applicant's/beneficiary's SSN in situations where a Social Security Card is not available.

Until SSNs with an SSN-VER code W are reverified via the SVES SSN Verification Process, a MEDS printout dated after September 25, 2009, with a W SSN-VER code may also be used by EWs to verify an applicant's/beneficiary's SSN in situations where a Social Security Card is not available.

Since the new SSN-VER code J no longer indicates a verified SSN, MEDS printouts dated after September 25, 2009, with a J SSN-VER code may no longer be used by EWs to verify an applicant's/beneficiary's SSN in situations where a Social Security Card is not available.

Please Note: The Income and Eligibility Verification System (IEVS) Abstract report (RS-IEV410-R001) shows two SSN Verification Codes. The first one (in the top section) is a generated value based on the IEVS response. It does not use the shared logic used for MEDS SSN-VER codes, and therefore, cannot be used in accordance with the policy stated above until that logic is corrected (watch upcoming Change Cycle letters for installation of the IEVS correction). The second SSN Verification Code (in the section labeled MEDS/CDB File) is taken from MEDS so it can be used in accordance with the policy stated above.

The following chart provides the old and new definitions of each SSN-VER code. Note: User-reported SSN-VER code values and definitions of those values have not changed.
