

SUBJECT: CHANGE OF LOCATION FOR COUNTIES TO SEND THE

MEDI-CAL DISABILITY PACKETS TO THE DISABILITY

DETERMINATION SERVICE DIVISION-STATE

PROGRAMS (DDSD-SP) EFFECTIVE APRIL 1, 2011.

The purpose of this Medi-Cal Eligibility Division Informational Letter (MEDIL) is to inform the counties of the appropriate DDSD-SP locations to send the Medi-Cal disability packets for the disability determinations.

There are currently no changes to the locations in the sending of disability packets by the counties except, Riverside and San Bernardino. These two counties have already been notified by the Department of Health Care Services of the change to their disability packets to the DDSD-SP Oakland Branch instead of the Los Angeles Branch effective April 1, 2011.

The following illustrates which DDSD-SP each county is to send their disability packets to effective April 1, 2011.
