- Re: California Newborn Hearing Screening Program Outpatient Infant Hearing Screening Provider Standards Update

This letter is to alert you to a change in the Outpatient Infant Hearing Screening Provider Standards (standards). The California Newborn Hearing Screening Program (NHSP) has updated our procedures to better reflect the recommendations of the Joint Committee on Infant Hearing **restricting otoacoustic emission (OAE) screening following a refer result on auditory brainstem response (ABR) screening**. The specific change has been bolded and can be found in the Facility and Equipment section (page 3) of the standards. Effective immediately, Outpatient Infant Hearing Screening Providers who do not have ABR equipment available shall not accept patients who require outpatient screening following a refer result on ABR.
