Activity or Program Name: Community Health Nurse

Activity or Program Description: The community health nurse (\$14,670.58) provided training on overdose recognition and naloxone administration to faculty and students in the Carlsbad Unified School District and other at-risk community groups in the city of Carlsbad. In addition, as part of a continuous quality improvement program, the community health nurse conducted ongoing surveillance of overdose-related medical responses. Reports with quality assurance updates and recommendations were distributed quarterly to medical emergency responders.
