Activity or Program Name: Youth Opioid/Drug Prevention Program

Activity or Program Description: A Youth Services Officer (YSO) was hired to run an opioid/drug prevention program targeting youth. The YSO interacts with youth throughout the city of Elk Grove, providing opioid/drug prevention education in schools, at community events, and via mentoring

and sports programs. The YSO is working to develop an evidence based youth program that discourages and prevents misuse of opioids. The time spent by the YSO on opioid remediation is proportionate to the funds spent on this expense and is a direct cost.
