**Activity or Program Description:** During FY 23-24 and into FY 24-25, Fresno County utilized funding to conduct significant planning work in partnership with a consultant firm that is experienced in launching community wide efforts with an emphasis on opioid abatement in collaboration with states and counties. That partnership has helped Fresno County to engage communitywide participation in the development of a needs assessment that will help our county to thoughtfully identify future spending priorities which may include implementing new or enhancing existing programs. This work has continued into FY 24-25; no additional activities were undertaken during this period.
