SUBJECT: ANNUAL DRUG MEDI-CAL-ORGANIZED DELIVERY SYSTEM COMPLIANCE FINDINGS REPORT

Dear Director Bell:

The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) is responsible for determining compliance to the requirements of the Drug Medi-Cal Organized Delivery System (DMC-ODS) Intergovernmental Agreement operated by Nevada County.

The Substance Use Disorder Review Section (SUDRS) within DHCS' Audits and Investigations' Contract and Enrollment Review Division (CERD) conducted a review of the County's compliance with Federal and State laws, Medi-Cal regulations, program requirements and the State's DMC-ODS contract. The review included an inspection of the County's policies for providing services, procedures to implement these policies, and the process to determine whether these policies were effective. Documents were reviewed and interviews were conducted with County staff. Enclosed are the results of Nevada County's Fiscal Year (FY) 2024-25 DMC-ODS compliance review.

This letter serves as notification that Nevada County has sufficiently demonstrated compliance with the reviewed Federal and State laws, Medi-Cal regulations, program requirements and contractual obligations. During the compliance review, no deficiencies or findings were identified, and no further action is required at this time.
