Activity or Program Name: Housing Navigator

Activity or Program Description: Partnering with Butte County Employment & Social Services for a Housing Navigator. Housing navigation provides a variety of services, specifically connecting unhoused and disadvantaged people of our community to drug treatment, mental health services, public health services and housing. Target subjects who are experiencing opioid use disorder, substance use disorder, low income, disabilities and disadvantaged. The connecting end of these services are Butte County Department of Employment and Social Services, Butte County Mental Health and Butte County Public Health. The City of Oroville maintains partnerships and memorandums of understanding with the Butte County Agencies. Community Navigator provides support for Opioid Use Disorder (OUD) and Substance Abuse Disorder/Mental Health (SUD/MH) by conducting daily outreach and using motivational interviewing to break down ambivalence to get the target community to move from precontemplation

and to contemplating. Community Navigator will conduct on-scene assessments and provide referrals. Community Navigator connects individuals to Drug Rehabilitation Centers for counseling and connects individuals with OUD to services that provide treatment, and other programs designed to address the misuse and abuse of opioid products, to treat or mitigate opioid use or related disorders, and mitigate other alleged effects of the opioid abuse crisis, including those injured as a result of the opioid abuse crisis.
