**Activity or Program Description:** The Pacifica Police Department purchased 10 Opioid Office Event Kits priced at \$119 each that are utilized when police officers are out in the field/community and respond to an event where a person experiencing opioid overdose and they have assessed that opioid overdose reversal is needed. 7 of the kits came with voice activated modules attached, with an added cost of \$40 for each. This totaled to \$1,470 but with a delivery fee of \$95 and a 4% discount, the final total was \$1,506.20. This kits contain naloxone nasal spray for the efforts of opioid overdose reversal.
