**Activity or Program Description:** Our Fentanyl Campaign received 2,400 units of naloxone in December 2023 to distribute to community members throughout the Antelope Valley while promoting education and prevention of opioid use. In partnership with local service providers, we attended various events to educate community members about the dangers of fentanyl and hosted Narcan trainings. We also purchased a canopy, campaign shirts and supplies for our campaign booth.
