Activity or Program Name: HealthRight360 - San Mateo MAT Clinic

Activity or Program Description: Health Right 360's San Mateo MAT Clinic provides primary care and Medication Assisted Treatment to people with opioid use disorder in San Mateo County. The clinic works closely with San Mateo County Behavioral Health Services and the Integrated Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) team to provide medical treatment for patients suffering from addiction, especially those with Opioid Use Disorder (OUD). The clinics staffed by addiction specialists who use current medications such as Suboxone and Sublocade to provider medical treatment for OUD and support patients in their recovery.

Activity or Program Name: One Life Counseling

Activity or Program Description: One Life Counseling Center’s Narcan Saves Life Program provides free Narcan training and distribution to the people in San Mateo County. Narcan is used to help reverse an opioid overdose. Through the Narcan Saves Life Program, an estimated 7,500 individuals were helped through training sessions and distributions. Narcans were distributed to schools, youth, and family-focused nonprofits, undocumented support groups, and at community events. One Life Counseling also engaged in community outreach efforts by designing, printing, distributing flyers, posters, educational materials to raise awareness about the availability of Narcan and training sessions to ensure that community members, schools, and organizations know about the program. Funds were used to pay for in house staff salary and materials for public outreach, training and distribution effort. Funds used for this program helped expand access to Narcan.
