**Activity or Program Name:** In Custody Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) Expansion - Santa Barbara County

**Activity or Program Description:** This activity builds on the current MAT program at the Sherriff office correctional facilities including all those in custody who qualify for treatment. In FY2022-23, the contracted healthcare provider within the jail system in Santa Barbara County enrolled approximately 150 individuals into the Medication Assisted Treatment program, providing opioid and alcohol use disorder medications and counseling to enrolled clients. In FY2023-24, utilizing funds from the Opioid settlement, the provider was able to enroll 431 clients, significantly expanding the incarcerated populations access to medications and counseling to support their alcohol and opioid use disorders. The vast majority of clients are opioid users. Enrolled MAT clients receive discharge planning and linkages to community providers before they are released to continue their medications and counseling while in the community. Two positions, a MAT Coordinator and SUD Counselor were added to support this program.
