HIAA 6: The purchase of naloxone for distribution and efforts to expand access to naloxone for opioid overdose reversals Please describe:	The City of Union City utilizes the distribution of Naloxone as a strategy for harm reduction, focusing on the prevention of overdoses and the identification of risk factors linked to opioid overdoses. Recognizing the symptoms of an opioid overdose and responding effectively is crucial in these circumstances. To facilitate this, the City provides training for both staff and community members, as Naloxone works rapidly to reverse an overdose by blocking the effects of opioids, frequently restoring normal breathing within 2 to 3 minutes for individuals whose respiratory function has been impaired due to an opioid overdose.

Activity#2

Activity or Program Name: Clipper Card Distribution Project

Activity or Program Description: The Participating Subdivision has acquired 150 Clipper Cards and initiated an educational awareness and distribution program for the City of Union City, designed to identify and reduce barriers to treatment. The main emphasis is on youth, community residents, and the unhoused individuals affected by opioid use disorders and other substance use disorders.
