- Scope of Services
- Enrollment
- Consumer Protections
- Evaluation Participation
- Maintaining regionalized provider network





# Challenges to Start Up

- Acceptance of Reimbursement Rates
- Ability to Meet All Readiness Requirements
- CMS Approval of Contracts
- Data Sharing



# Project Evaluation

- Improvement in care coordination
- Improvement in quality of care
- Reduction in rate of growth in spending
- Improvement in the value or cost effectiveness of care
- Improvement in patient and family satisfaction
- Improvement in provider satisfaction
- Change in the distribution of mix of services (reduction in ER and inpatient services and increased use of community based services)
