

Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Performance Review Report
Siskiyou County Program Review
October 20, 2025

FINDINGS

Finding #1: Siskiyou County did not include documentation of achievement in performance outcomes for Community Services and Support (CSS) in the adopted Fiscal Year (FY) 2023-26 Three-Year Program and Expenditure Plan (Plan). (County Performance Contract (6)(A)(5)(d); (Welfare and Institution Code (W&I Code) section 5848)).

Recommendation #1: The County must provide evidence of compliance for achievement in performance outcomes for each CSS program, specifically for the Six Stones Wellness Center, all Full-Service Partnership (FSP) programs, Homeless Outreach, and the Crisis Intervention and Response program for FY 2023-24. The County did provide an annual report with Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) performance outcomes.

SUGGESTED IMPROVEMENTS

Suggested Improvement #1: The County did not consistently enter into an FSP agreement with each client served under the FSP service category, and when appropriate the client's family during the chart documentation review. The County acknowledged this inconsistency, and had already implemented correct policies, procedures and training prior to the chart documentation review. DHCS recommends the County continue to use the implemented policies, procedures and training provided.

Suggested Improvement #2: The County did not show consistent evidence of identifying client driven goals on the Individual Services Support Plan (ISSP), or similar document per Behavior Health Information Notice (BHIN) 23-068 during the chart documentation review. The County acknowledged this inconsistency, and had already implemented corrective policies, procedures, and training prior to the chart documentation review. DHCS recommends the County continue to use the implemented policies, procedures, and training provided.
