

**Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Performance Review Report
San Bernardino County Program Review
August 23, 2022**

FINDINGS

Finding #1: San Bernardino County did not provide a description of the county demographics, including, but not limited to size of the county, threshold languages, unique characteristics, age, gender, race/ethnicity in the adopted Fiscal Year (FY) 2021-22 Annual Update (Update). However the demographics were located in the Three-Year Program and Expenditure Plan (Plan). (California Code of Regulations, title 9, section 3300(b)(4); Mental Health Services Oversight & Accountability Commission (MHSOAC) FY 2015-2016 MHSA Annual Update Instructions (p 5); MHSOAC FY 2014-2015 Through FY 2016-2017 MHSA Plan Instructions (pg 4)).

Recommendation #1: The County must provide a description of the demographics of the county, including but not limited to, size of the county, threshold languages, unique characteristics, age, gender, and race/ethnicity, in each subsequent adopted Plan and Update thereafter.

Finding #2: San Bernardino County did not include the Annual Prevention and Early Intervention (PEI) Report as a part of the adopted FY 2020-23 Plan or FY 2021-22 Update. (Cal. Code of Regs., tit. 9, § 3560.010).

Recommendation #2: The County must include the Annual PEI Report as a part of each subsequent adopted Plan or Update thereafter. The Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) will accept the following in lieu of the Annual PEI Report being a part of the Plan or Update: an addendum, an attachment, a link to the report or located on the county's website; as long as reference is made in the Plan or Update where the report may be found.
