

Mental Health Services Act (MHSA) Performance Review Report
Yolo County Program Review
June 10, 2024

FINDINGS

Finding #1:

Yolo County did not submit the Fiscal Year (FY) 2020-23 MHSA Three-Year Program and Expenditure Plan (Plan) to Department of Health Care Services (DHCS) within 30 days after adoption. (Welfare and Institution Code (W&I Code) Section 5847(a)).

Recommendation #1:

The County must submit the adopted MHSA Plan and/or Annual Update (Update) to DHCS within 30 days after adoption in each subsequent Plan and Update thereafter.

SUGGESTED IMPROVEMENTS

Suggested Improvement #1:

DHCS recommends the county indicate the number of Child, Transition Aged Youth (TAY), Adults, and Older Adults to be served, and indicate the cost per person for each Innovation (INN) project in each adopted Plan and Update.

Suggested Improvement #2:

DHCS recommends the county identify in their Full-Service Partnership (FSP) policy and procedure that a Personal Service Coordinator (PSC)/Case Manager or other qualified individual known to the client/family is available to respond to the client/family 24 hours a day, 7 days a week to provide after-hours interventions.
